## Our offer

The Zhengzhou University of Technology collaborates on the Efficient and Green Logistics Management along the Silk Road (GreenSilk for short) with the University of Bremen, Germany. One part of this four-year collaboration is student mobility. In 2023, there are **three one-month € 750 grants for bachelor or master students** in addition to an economy air return ticket. The mobility time will start with the lecture time of summer semester 2023 at the University of Bremen: 11/Apr/2023. Nominated students will be expected to:

- work over a pre-defined topic in the university library,
- elaborate a study plan with at least 3 courses weekly, taught in English and
- make a report / presentation about their stay.

The nomination will be decided following an online interview. After the nomination you will have to find accommodation and to apply for a visa.
